Fracture Management Overview - OSCEstop

Shaft fractures are often managed surgically to reduce time non-weight bearing Medial or bicondylar tibial plateau fractures (ie Schatzker Iv or more) require surgical fixation Ankle fractures require surgical fixation if they are: bimalleolar, trimalleolar, or disrupt the syndesmosis (ie Weber C and some Weber B) Tibial plateau Hinge brace
